Japanese Classes

International students can enroll in Japanese Language and Japanese Culture classes that are designed especially for university students who come to Japan.

Japanese Tutor; Various Subjects Tutor

Japanese tutors and various subject tutors are available for freshmen and sophomore international students.

Conversation Partner

International students have the opportunity to be paired with a Japanese student for friendship-- to become more acquainted with life in Japan.

Japanese Arts and Culture Appreciation

Programs for experiencing and appreciating Japanese Art and Culture are available.



Homestay/Home Visit

International students are invited to do a one night home stay with a Japanese family, or to visit a family for a half day. It's a great chance to experience a Japanese home and family life.

Exemption of Tuition for International Students

Student visa holders can receive a tuition exemption by meeting certain requirements.

The Naka Aihara Chokai Summer Festival

Students may take part in the local summer festival wearing a yukata, traditional Japanese summer clothing. The festival takes place in Naka Aihara Chokai, near the Machida Campus, and homemade festival foods are offered.
